Safety Regulations

1. No jeeps, limos, checker cabs, imperials, or convertibles (no trucks). 4cyls. May use imports. All glass, including head-lights, tail-lights, mirrors, front windshield, etc must be removed. **NOTE:** this must be done **BEFORE** the car is brought to the track.
2. Stock gas tanks must be removed. A marine tank custom steel tank or original tank (only with fuel pump factory installed inside) must be securely mounted in the back seat area. After inspection tanks, must be covered with a fire proof shield. Must have leak proof steel or rubber lines. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Cars with electrical fuel pumps must have a safety shut off switch mounted to centre of top of dash.
3. No special bumpers or reinforcements allowed, all trailer titches must be removed.
4. Two 1" welds are permitted on each door on door skin at locking jam. No welding and window frame allowed, only wire or duct tape. A post to post bar may be installed for driver safety. It can only be mounted from door post to door post, not to frame or sub frame on floor. Post to Post Bar must be bolted in, not welded, and can be no larger than 3" diameter and no greater than 1/8th inch wall.
5. All cars must have approved working seat belts. Drivers must wear CSA approved helmets and long pants (No shorts).
6. All cars must have full charged approved Fire Extinguishers within reach of the driver.
7. Driver's door **MUST BE PAINTED WHITE**, and clear of numbers and lettering.
8. Trunks and hoods must be open for inspection and can only be wired shut for safety crew to access quickly in case of emergency.

9. Battery must be moved to passenger's front floor and contained in a box or container. After inspection it must be covered by a fire proof shield. **(Only one 12 volt battery allowed).**
10. Large holes in floor and sunroof must be patched with metal.
11. Driver's door window **CANNOT** be covered with mesh or crash bars.
12. No modified suspension allowed, stock body mounts only; frames cannot have modifications or welding. No boxing channel frames.
13. No other welding is allowed. Used cars with frame damage may be fixed only on two sides, only with no bigger than ¼' plate.
14. Hoods must be wired down **(after inspection)**. Must have 12" hole in hood.
15. Radiator must be in stock position – filled with water only.
16. **All cars must have brakes before beginning of any heat.**
17. Additional safety rules may be imposed at the time of the derby if the Officials deem it necessary.
18. **FLAGS: Red – STOP, Black – DISQUALIFIED, Green – GO.** These **MUST** be obeyed by all drivers.
19. No intentional head-ons.
20. All drivers and pit crew must wear bracelets (1 for driver and 1 for mechanic per team which are included in entry fee). Additional pit crew bacelets available at additional cost.
21. No unauthorized persons allowed in pit area (includes girlfriends, wives and children) during derby. **No Exceptions.** Failure to obey this rule will result in disqualification, forfeit of entry fee and you will be asked to pack up and leave the grounds. **No Exceptions.**

Contest Rules and Regulations

1. The derby will start at 1pm sharp. Cars must be on the grounds by 11 am for inspection.
2. All contestants must report of the Officials by 10am to register.
3. Entry fee is \$45.00. This covers the driver of the car and one mechanic (per car). Extra crew bracelets can be [purchased for an additional cost of \$15 each.
4. There will be two hard luck heats to qualify 1st and 2nd place cars to the feature.
5. Drivers must be 16 years of age. If under 18years of age, driver and parent must sign a waiver with ID in front of fair board member.
6. All drivers must fill out an entry form and waiver.
7. All drivers must supply their own car.
8. **Only one driver and one mechanic** will be permitted in the pit area per car.
9. **ABSOLUTELY NO alcoholic beverages or drugs will be permitted in the pit area or on the track. This will result in immediate disqualification.**
10. Only the first 40 cars entered will be accepted.
11. **ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS MUST BE OBSERVED AND OBEYED.** Track operators or promoters reserve the right to approve or reject any or all entries. Fireman's decision is final.
12. There will be a bin provided to put your scrap metal in, and help to lad if necessary.
13. All cars must be removed from fairgrounds immediately **after Derby or loaded on trailer ready to go that night. If**

**arrangements have been made by a fair board member,
vehicles may be picked up the next day.**

14. MAIN heats: 1st wins \$100 and trophy
2nd wins \$ 50 and trophy

15. FEATURE: 1st wins \$400 and trophy
2nd wins \$200 and trophy
