Special Rules Governing the Goat Show

1. General rules which are applicable will apply to this show.
2. Entries will not be accepted unless membership fee of \$5.00 (if not previously paid) accompanies entry. Entries to be made on entry form enclosed on prize list.
3. Animals must be in position by 10 am, Sunday, July 15, 2018. Judging to commence at 12:00 noon.
4. Animals will not be allowed to leave grounds until 4:00 p.m. Anyone removing animals before specified time will forfeit prize money.
5. Milkers must be milked dry within 12 hours before judging commences. Goats with hard, distended udder may be disqualified at the discretion of the judge.
6. All goats entered in specials must be entered in respective classes to which they belong.
7. All purebred goats must be registered in the Canadian Goat Society and must be tattooed.
8. Registration papers must be on site. **NO REGISTRATION PAPER? NO-SHOW ENFORCED.**
9. Kids under 3 months of age are not eligible for competition.
10. Registered and grade animals are restricted to showing only in the classes provided. Nil cross-showing.
11. Unless there is competition in any one class, no exhibitor will be awarded more than two prizes.
12. No more than two animals may be shown in each individual class by an exhibitor.
13. It will be an open show.

NOTE: All showmen to be dressed in white. All exhibitors showing animals are responsible to scoop your poop and leave the area clean for the net exhibitors.

Portable pens would be appreciated if in your possession, so that the show can be better organized.
