

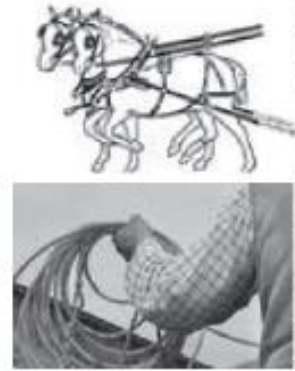

EASTERN ONTARIO PONY PULLERS ASSOCIATION - RULES

1. Light Pony Class - ponies must measure 48" and under
Heavy Pony Class - ponies must measure 56" and under
2. A person may enter and drive as many teams as he may like to in each class.
3. A team or pony may draw in one class only.
4. There is to be no interference whatsoever by the helpers while ponies are drawing. If so, draw will be disqualified.
5. A teamster is allowed two helpers if he/she so desires.
6. Teamsters or helpers are not allowed at ponies' heads while hitching or drawing.
7. There is to be no cursing, swinging of lines or beating ponies with ends of lines while ponies are hitched or drawing.
8. Teamsters and helpers are to stay behind whiffletrees while ponies are drawing.
9. Teamsters and helpers are not allowed to touch, push or slap ponies with hands. No check slaps allowed.
10. In case of break in harness, time to be repaired will be determined by the Judge.
11. Two complete draws totalling fifteen (15) feet are required. There will be two (2) tries to pull the load a distance of fifteen (15) feet. The ponies while pulling must stay within the course lines or be disqualified from that attempt only.
12. Any movement under four (4) inches will be considered a chuck if the teamster is trying to hold the team - this will not be considered a pull.
13. Teamster, upon entering the pulling area will have two (2) minutes to hitch, and four (4) minutes to complete his pull.
14. Any teamster or helper arguing with the Judge will automatically be ejected from the contest.
15. Any team considered dangerous in the opinion of the Judge and pull committee will be disqualified from the remainder of the competition.



16. Once a team has a draw, the teamster must remain teamster for the balance of the contest.
17. All teamsters and helpers must be properly dressed for the occasion.
18. All decisions made by the Judge are final.
19. There shall be no alcoholic beverages used by teamsters, helpers or officials.
