TRACTOR PULL AT ODESSA FAIR ANTIQUE & FARM STOCK

- Participants will enter the grounds from Shane Street, watch for signs.
 The driver and one pit crew per tractor will be admitted to the grounds free. All others will be charged the regular fair entrance fee.
- A meeting of all participants will be held at 4:50pm to review the rules and regulations.

Registration & Weight In

Starts at 4pm

Pull Start time: 5pm

Entry Fee: \$10 per class

Antique: 3500, 4500, 5500, and 6500 Tractors are 1960 or older, have original drawbar in original position, original motor and tractor not altered in any way.

Farm Stock: 3500, 4500, 5500, 6500, 7500, 8500, 10500 and 12500. The tractor has the original motor, can be any year and has had upgrades to motor, hitch is no more than 20 inches from ground.

No modified classes.

Tractor Pull Rules:

- 1. Drawbars must be solid mount having no movement in any direction and are to be no higher than 20inches from the ground level.
- 2. No pulling from 3 point hitch lift arms or top link.
- 3. All tractors must have the engine throttle controlled only by the manufacturer's original throttle linkage unless equipped with a dead man throttle.
- 4. All tractors must have solid fenders.
- 5. No weights are allowed behind the rear axle. All hanging weights must be forward of the rear axle with the exception of wheel weights.
- 6. All tractor operators are to remain seated during the pull, be in complete control of the tractor at all times and follow the instructions of the track official.
- 7. Any weights or parts falling from tractors while pulling will result in disqualification.
- 8. Competitors must be 18 years of age, be an experienced operator, and all competitors and pit crew will sign a release.
- 9. Officials reserve the right to re-weigh winner.
- 10. Winner of class has option to move up to next class.
- 11. Front wheels of tractor lifting more than 36 inches off the ground will be disqualified by the track official.
- 12. Tractors that go out of bounds while pulling are automatically disqualified by the track official.
- 13. Tractors pull in order of registration of their class.
- 14. No helpers allowed on track or tractors during a pull.
- $15. \ \ Tractors\ must\ be\ in\ neutral\ while\ being\ hooked\ and\ unhooked.$
- 16. Pull is over when forward motion has ended and all tractors must stop immediately upon signal from officials.
- 17. Only one pull is allowed unless a tie is declared. A second attempt will be allowed if the driver terminated the first attempt within 50′ of the starting point for adjustments. The test puller, first registered for the class, has the option of another pull.
- 18. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be permitted in the pit area or on the track.
- 19. The decision of the track officials is Final.
- 20. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will NOT be tolerated and will result in disqualification and you may be asked to leave the grounds.
- 21. Helmets are recommended but is left to the discretion of the individual driver.
